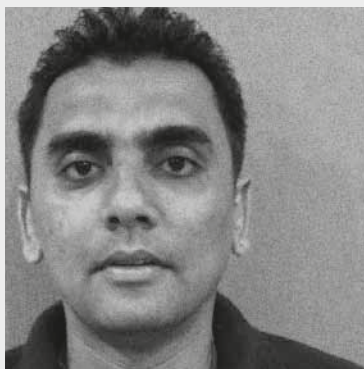
#### About Me
